'Carols' are something most of us associate with Christmas. But what is a 'carol' and how is it different from a hymn or a song? 'Carol' originally referred to 'a ring-dance or the song accompanying it' but a more modern definition is 'a song of joy or praise; a Christmas song or hymn'.



Although when we speak of carols we generally mean Christmas carols, there are 'carols' for other seasons of the year as well, for example Easter, Saint's days and Advent (the 4 weeks leading up to Christmas Day). Going 'carolling' has been a winter activity for hundreds of years — cheering people up in the dark cold evenings with merry songs, not necessarily of a religious nature but celebrating life and music and being together.

Essentially a carol is a joyful song created and sung by ordinary people. Their subjects are down-to-earth and include references to plants and animals, food and drink. While, in the middle ages, the church sang Gregorian chant in Latin, the people sang and danced to crols in the street, the home and the inn.

At Christmas time we remember how God, the creator of the universe, came down to earth, to share our lives in all their joys and sorrows and we celebrate by singing God's praise in our churches, schools, streets and pubs. Come and join us at one (or more!) of the many carol services in our village churches or singing around our streets.
