On Thursday 20th February 2020 there was a poignant memorial service at Ramsholt Quay, led by Reverend Michael Hatchett, for the American air crew whose B17 Flying Fortress crashed into the river Deben 75 years ago, with only 2 survivors. There was a military flypast, Bawdsey School pupils read out poems, relatives from America spoke movingly and WWII vehicles from RAF Debach were on display. George Collins, the harbour master, talked of playing on the plane when he was 14 and added 'it was the only plane I've been in is the one on the beach'. Bacon baps and



warming coffee served at The Ramsholt Arms were very welcome as the wind buffeted the band and bagpipes accompanied the laying of the wreath.
